

WOMEN'S INTER-SCHOOL GOLF CHALLENGE CUP

GENERAL FORMAT

Cost per person includes green fees, charity donation, lunch and trophies

PLAYER INFORMATION

EVENT

Thirty teams of past students of member schools compete in an 18-hole stableford event. The number of players from each school is four. Teams are mixed in flights of four players with a shotgun start. Starting holes are allocated in order of receipt of school team entry.

All four stableford scores returned by old girls of each respective school will be added together and the total will represent the score for that school. The school with the highest aggregate score shall hold the cup for one year. Each member of the winning team shall receive a trophy. Individual trophies are awarded in two divisions — Daily Handicaps Scratch to 18, and 19 to 35. Trophies are awarded for nearest the pin. A stall of home-made produce, vegetables, pckles, jams, cakes etc also contributes its proceeds towards our charity. We encourage all participants to donate things to the stall and also to purchase items. A lucky ticket competition is always held on the day for an excellent choice of prizes.

Team entries are submitted by each school representative.

CONDITIONS

The event is open to players who are past students of a member school and who hold a current GA Handicap (**limit 35**). Following the recommendation of *Golf Australia*, the GA Handicap will be used to allocate handicap category for the individual trophies. The Daily Handicap may be different to the GA Handicap and will be used for scoring against the card. In the event of a tie normal count back procedures will be employed.

Players	are required to provide their School Representative with:
	their <i>Golflink</i> number and GA Handicap (limit 35)
	information about any specific dietary requirement
	carts booked by individual players with Commonwealth GC (must be pre-booked, and requires a medical
	certificate)

A single team entry nominating four players is submitted by the nominated school representative. Entries close two weeks before the event at 5pm. No late entries will be accepted.

The Committee has full power to alter or vary the conditions of the program if they deem it necessary or desirable. The entry fee includes the green fee and lunch and varies with the club at which the event is held.
